Certified photocopies are required if the application is to be lodged by post.
- 5. Any birth certificates in your possession are to be returned for cancellation. Copies of the amended birth certificate showing the father's details can be obtained by completing an application form and paying the prescribed fee of \$48.00 plus \$13.30 if postage is required.
- 6. Do you want your child's surname to be changed to that of the Father?
